

Nuneaton & Bedworth Council; Armson Road, Landscape works

In 2018 Impart links Maintain were successful in winning a tender for Nuneaton & Bedworth Council for a call off contract for soft landscaping. ILM currently complete 2 soft landscaping projects per month.

Projects range in size from fencing to fully designed and specified projects, which are completed in line with tendered rates.

### Providing Complete, Turnkey, Managed Solutions

Nuneaton and Bedworth council identified the works required which Impart links then managed.

Works completed:

- Remove and replace 41m of fencing
- Lay 174m<sup>2</sup> of turf
- Install Concrete base and build retaining wall with opening for step, including brick on edge to top and weep holes.
- Lay 17m<sup>2</sup> of new slabs
- Put down 2m<sup>2</sup> of pea gravel edgings
- Brickwork repairs to approx. 20 bricks
- Remove old outhouse corrugated plastic roofing, door and all timber work, point old holes

The Project Manager visited site regularly to oversee all works, H&S practices as well as engage with stakeholders; client, neighbours, resident etc.

Operatives work respectfully; No power tools before 8 or after 5. Limiting noise wherever possible.



Traffic management ILM plans in place to limit inconvenience. No deliveries made at school run times.

Our direct labour trained, experienced grounds work team carried out all works, led by our onsite supervisor, with all works signed off by our project Manager.

Tenant Liaison was on-going and led by our ILM TLO, Sophie Brydges.

Garden clearance produces a lot of waste, and it is important to leave the site tidy and safe all times.

Regular removals of waste to recycling depots were completed to ensure a safe clean site.



All H&S/CDM actions and paperwork completed including all risk assessments and method statements.
