

Environmental Policy Statement

Impart links is an ISO 14001 qualified company and are committed to sustainable waste management across our business and operations. We aim to reduce the company's overall consumption and usage of raw materials. Staff are encouraged to re-use materials in all areas of the business. Throughout the business promote recycling and the benefits of utilising recycled materials. When disposal is the only option we seek to dispose of materials in an environmentally sensitive and responsible way. In order to accomplish this we carry out the following:

- We carefully plan our work; we know what needs to be done, where and when. This makes material allocation more accurate and reduces waste
- Materials are sourced locally to avoid unnecessary long travel.
- We ask our merchants not to use packaging or plastic when issuing materials unless absolutely necessary.
- We use sustainable suppliers and ensure sustainability claims by vetting all potential suppliers
- Employ local labour for contracts where we can directly employ staff, for sustained contracts such as this one including key staff and Supervisors, thus reducing travel distances.
- We try and actively share vehicles, we will always travel in one vehicle whenever possible.
- We keep an Inventory of Stored Materials so where useable surplus material is generated it is retained, stored and reused.
- We have a waste transfer licence and relationships with recycling plants for "recyclable waste drop-off" reducing the need for skips.
- Sale of reusable materials can help us reduce costs, and reduces potential waste. Alternatively, materials may be donated to community enterprise/ initiatives.

Impart links is aware that the correct handling, storage and disposal of materials is important to insure compliance with environmental legislation and for pollution prevention. We keep up to date with changes in the legal framework so that we always fully comply with Duty of Care responsibilities.

We encourage co-operation and communication between our employees, subcontractors and clients towards our shared goal of reducing waste and reusing and recycling where possible.
